Following on from the success of last year's 'Summer at the Beach' exhibition in July, we are in the process of organising a further event, involving a growing number of artists who live in Waterbeach. Last year was again a real success as it opened the Barracks doors to the village and it was wonderful to see people of all ages walking through those barriers enjoying the art and participating in the various workshops we held. We want to make the use of the space while it is available, and for as long as possible, keeping the momentum going of tying the Barracks to the village community.

In addition to last year's activities we plan to organise the following:

- Working in partnerhsip with Cams Conservation Society on an artwork created with materials salvaged from the Cam at Waterbeach, highlighting the importance of the river to our community.
- Display a collection of a local collector of histrionic bicycles, highlighting the increasing importance of cycling to our community.

We also wish to build on last year's success with an emphasis on the following:

- Provide free space and support for community organisations to hold events and raise their profile, including the Repair Café, Cambridge Cycling Network and Waterbeach Community Land Trust.
- Work in partnership with the adjacent Waterbeach Barracks Museum to increase their visitor figures and support.
- Enable people living in south Cambridgeshire to have access to a stimulating cultural event that is accessible on many levels and for a range of age groups and inclusive of all members of the community.
- Provide a specific activity for children and families to reach a family audience.

We need your help as, without this funding, the event would be far less successful and we really want to celebrate all that is wonderful about our village, as well as promoting new art events and raising the profile of local community organisations.
